

IS YOUR DGPS EQUIPMENT AUTHORISED?

The frequency used by your DGPS equipment
must be licensed ... it's the law!



If you've bought or rented Differential GPS (DGPS) equipment with the frequencies pre-programmed and intend to use the supplier's licence to operate the device, you **MUST** have their written authorisation.

You should know:



The frequencies
you're allowed to use



The duration of the
authorisation



The location you're
allowed to operate in



Any other conditions
that must be met

As well as causing interference, unlicensed operation means your company could be fined or taken to court.
